

Excursion destinations

Some of the most beautiful excursion destinations in Styria can be found in the Mürzer Oberland Nature Park.



Here you will find the famous Neuberg Abbey (photo below) with its remarkable cathedral, the natural jewel "Wasserfall zum Toten Weib", the Kaiserhof glass manufactory with its show glass blowing workshop or the "klimawandeln" adventure trail, the first adventure trail on the subject of climate change in Austria.

Other highlights include the Schaubberger Triftanlage with its newly designed show tunnel and the nature museum in Neuberg Abbey, which is currently being renovated and is expected to reopen in 2024. The Roßlochklamm adventure trail will no longer be open due to the continuing danger of falling rocks.

Of course, the world's largest spinning wheel in Kapellen, the relaxing and wheelchair-accessible "Forest of the Senses", the Montanarum mining museum in Altenberg an der Rax and the woodcutter and local history museum in Lanau near Mürzsteg are also worth a visit.

At the Urani pond complex, a large adventure playground awaits all children in addition to the bathing ponds with boat hire, volleyball court and table tennis table.

As you can see, the Mürzer Oberland Nature Park offers numerous excursion destinations for young and old, old and young at heart. And it's only an hour's drive from Vienna or Graz, just above the Semmering.
